What is the Power Saver Rewards Program?

The Power Saver Rewards Program is a free, voluntary program offered by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) that rewards participants for temporarily reducing energy use when the demand for electricity is high.



An EPO Membership Update and Recruitment Committee is Needed

- The EPO membership database includes data that is several years old.
- We have VERIFIED coverage of only around 27% of the entries and streets without entries.
- We have UNCHECKED data for another 51%, that we can verify by phone or email.
- Lastly, we have NO DATA for another 22% of the entries, and this will require “Boots on the Ground”, with people knocking on doors and talking to residents.
