






# Resident Count and Average Age by Mutual




January 2023

## What we're doing



With the input of EPO coordinators and their teams, we're developing and designing a training video giving our EPO teams an accessible, "anytime, anywhere" on demand mechanism.

We envision that this video training can become a strong and supportive tool for continuing and enhancing EPO's work & mission in our local entries/neighborhoods.

## Why a training video?

Help Wanted: Creating an EPO Training Video

Information retention rates of 65% (video) vs 25% (on site/in person).

75% of people more likely to watch a video than access material through reading.

People forget 90% of what they've learned through reading or on-site training after 6 months!
