

# As You are Evacuating Your Rossmoor Home (1 of 2):



- Mandatory Evacuation Order: Leave within 15 Minutes
- Leave Voluntarily if You Feel Unsafe
- Place Pets in Carriers when Evacuation Warning is Given
- Follow all Directions Provided by Civil Authorities
- Take Fastest Route on Paved Roads Downhill toward Valley Floor
- Temporary Evacuation Points (TEP's)

# As You are Evacuating Your Rossmoor Home (2 of 2):



- Car versus Walking Out in Evacuations
- Turn on Head Lights and Run Car A/C in Recirculate Mode with Car Windows Up
- Tune Car Radio to KCBS All News (740 AM or 106.9 FM) or KQED (88.5 FM)
- Wear a Vented N-95 Mask, Natural Fiber Clothes, Hat, Closed-Toed Shoes/Boots and Eye Goggles
- Leave with your Grab n' Go Bag for All in Household (including Pets)
- Never Use Alternate Exits out of Rossmoor unless Directed by Civil Authorities

# Returning Home to Rossmoor After Evacuating: (1 of 2):



- Wait for the “All-Clear” Order to Return
- Never Return at Night: Visibility is Paramount to Safety
- Drive with Headlights On: Degraded Air Quality Hampers Visibility
- Watch for Workers Restoring Services in Impacted Areas
- Do Not Drive Around any Barricades
- Carefully Inspect Outside Manor Perimeter First

# Returning Home to Rossmoor After Evacuating: (2 of 2):



- Do not Enter Home if Structurally Damaged
- Do Not Enter if You Smell Gas or Hear a Hissing or Blowing Sound (Gas Leaks)
- Do Not Smoke, Light a Match, Light a Candle or Use any Flame until Safe
- Wait for the “All Clear” Water Quality Announcement before Drinking any Water
- Expect "Boil Water” Orders and Intermittent Power Outages
- Stay Informed through our Real-Time Emergency Alerts (Rossmoor Nixle, CCC CWS and WCAAlert)
